DEPUTY MINISTER ENERGY & CLIMATE CHANGE COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

AUTHORITY

This Terms of Reference is established under the authority of the Government of the Northwest Territories Senior Management Committee of Deputy Ministers.

MANDATE

The mandate of the Deputy Minister Energy & Climate Change Committee is to provide an interdepartmental focus to identify issues, track efforts, coordinate policy, and offer recommendations to:

- (a) collaboration with other governments and organizations on addressing climate change;
- (b) options for climate change adaptation and mitigation;
- (c) energy policy;
- (d) making and incentivizing investments in alternative energy solutions;
 - (e) communications about government approaches to energy and climate change issues.

CHAIR AND DM LEADS

Mr. Paul Guy shall Chair the Deputy Minister Energy & Climate Change Committee and is the DM Lead for the Energy & Climate Change Committee-of-Cabinet.

COMPOSITION

The Committee comprises the:

- Deputy Minister of Infrastructure
- Deputy Minister of Finance
- Deputy Minister of Industry, Tourism and Investment
- Deputy Minister of Environment and Natural Resources
- · Deputy Minister of Executive and Indigenous Affairs
- President, Northwest Territories Housing Corporation
- President, Northwest Territories Power Corporation

All Deputy Ministers have a standing invitation to attend Committee meetings.

QUORUM

The Chair and any four individuals appointed to the Committee constitute a quorum.

OPERATIONS

The Committee:

- (a) will remain informed of emerging issues and challenges related to the Committee's mandate;
- (b) will prepare a work plan of specific actions and initiatives that support a focused, coordinated, government-wide approach to the development and implementation of the committee's mandate;
- (c) may establish subcommittees to help carry out the Committee's operation;
- (d) may establish meeting procedures and policies necessary to the Committee's operations;
- (e) will meet monthly or as required at the call of the Chair;
- (f) will record and track decisions and related actions; and

(g) will report as needed to the Senior Management Committee of Deputy Ministers.

OPERATIONAL SUPPORT

The Office of Priorities & Planning, Department of Executive and Indigenous Affairs, will provide the Committee with policy and administrative support; Corporate Communications, Department of Executive and Indigenous Affairs, will provide communications support.
